Eerde Summer Camp Benefits Summed Up

Master your English

Our courses are designed to provide an intensive yet enjoyable and interactive learning environment for participants to improve their English skills.

Accommodation

Upon arrival participants will be assigned a room; the communal (kitchen) areas and on-site laundry facilities are open to all participants. Staff is onsite (and available 24/7) throughout their stay to support and guide participants. We offer an onsite gym for which an induction session is mandatory should participants wish to use the facilities.

Meals

Included in the fee are three nutritious meals a day, all prepared daily by our chef using fresh local products. Advance notice is required for special dietary or religious food restrictions. Throughout the day and during off campus activities, healthy snacks, fruits, filtered or bottled water will be available.



Staffing & Supervision

All through our program, participants will be supervised and cared for by our Summer Camp Team. Contact details of our Camp Coordinator and supervisor will be distributed upfront. The coordinator will lead the programme and oversee all organizational planning, staffing and practical issues that may arise during the camp. Please note that participants may be left unsupervised at intervals, especially should they choose not to join optional activities.

Practical Information

Cancellation and Refunds

- Cancellation with full refund is possible until 22 June 2019
- No refund is possible for cancellations after 22 June 2019

Visa

- EU Nationals (people able travel to the Netherlands without a visa) do not need to arrange a visa
- Non-EU Nationals must apply for the appropriate visa. We can issue a visa support letter upon request

Flights

Eerde Summer Camp fees do not include flights. The arrival day is set one day before the official Eerde Summer Camp kick-off.
All participants are required to arrive on the set arrival date and time, which will be announced in the confirmation e-mail after registration.

Arrival/Departure Transfers

Eerde can arrange transfers between the airport and Eerde upon request. Eerde Summer Camp Fees do not include transfers. Please inform the Camp Coordinator upfront if this service is required.

Welcome Reception and Graduation

Parents/families are invited to join festivities organised to celebrate the beginning and end of Eerde Summer Camp.

Medical and Dietary Information

All participants are required to complete a Medical and Dietary form. The chef will cater to all (religious) dietary needs, provided they have been specified upfront.

Insurance

Personal medical and travel insurance for participants is not included in the Eerde Summer Camp Fee.

Please be advised that it is obligatory for all participants to send a copy of their individual medical and travel insurance policy upon admission to the programme.

FEES & PAYMENT

Costs for joining our summer camp are € 1.250,- per week*.

*Single room option available upon request and additional costs. **Full payment before 22nd of June 2019.**

We operate on a first-come first-serv base. Places on the camp can only be confirmed once full payment of the programme fee is received. Payment to be made by bank transfer, please notify the Camp Coordinator once payment is made.

Code of Conduct

All applicants are required to sign and adhere to the Eerde Code of Honour. The Code outlines the programme rules and regulations, and expected behaviour and conduct towards fellow participants and staff members. Should the Code of Honour be breached, parents will be informed and the student may be removed from the programme. Additionally, parents/guardians have to complete the Summer Camp Participation Agreement and the Parent/Guardian Consent Form, which can be found in the attachment of the confirmation e-mail after application.

Safety Regulations

To safeguard the well being of our participants and staff, we implement strict measures to guarantee safety for our participants and staff members at all times.

These measures include:

- · Introduction session to campus facilities and routines
- · 24-hour on-site staffing throughout the programme
- · Nightly curfew times
- · Strict adherence to single-sex dorm rooms
- · Zero tolerance for alcohol and substance use by any participants or members of staff
